
Portrush is a very popular seaside resort.



COUNTY ARMAGH


Armagh City is the county town of County Armagh.

Carlow is the county town in County Carlow. Known for archaeology which is finding remains and artifacts left by the people who lived long ago.




COUNTY CAVAN



COUNTY CLARE


The county town is Ennis. County Clare is known as "The Banner County" due to its history of symbolic banners for important political events. The Cliffs of Moher is a major tourist attraction,






COUNTY CORK

COUNTY DONEGAL


Donegal County is known for its wild, rugged beauty, as well

Donegal is the main town of the county.






COUNTY DOWN

County Galway is known as "The Cultural Heart of Ireland" with Irish language, music, song and dance traditions. The county town is Galway, the festival capital of Ireland.






COUNTY KERRY

COUNTY KILDARE


County Kildare is known as "The Equine County" and famous for the quality of horses bred in the many stud farms as well as horse training and racing. Naas is the county town.


COUNTY KILKENNY

comedy festivals, the Kilkenny "Cat Laughs" festival.




COUNTY LAOIS


COUNTY LEITRIM


COUNTY LIMERICK


COUNTY LOUTH

COUNTY MEATH




COUNTY MONAGHAN

The county town is Monaghan.




COUNTY OFFALY


COUNTY TIPPERARY


COUNTY WATERFORD


COUNTY WESTMEATH
